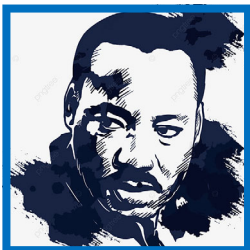
## NUESTRO PLAN DE ACCIÓN DE LAUDATO SI DE LA PARROQUIA

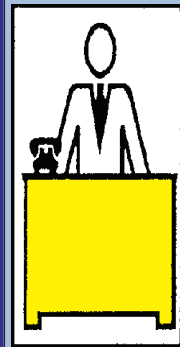
