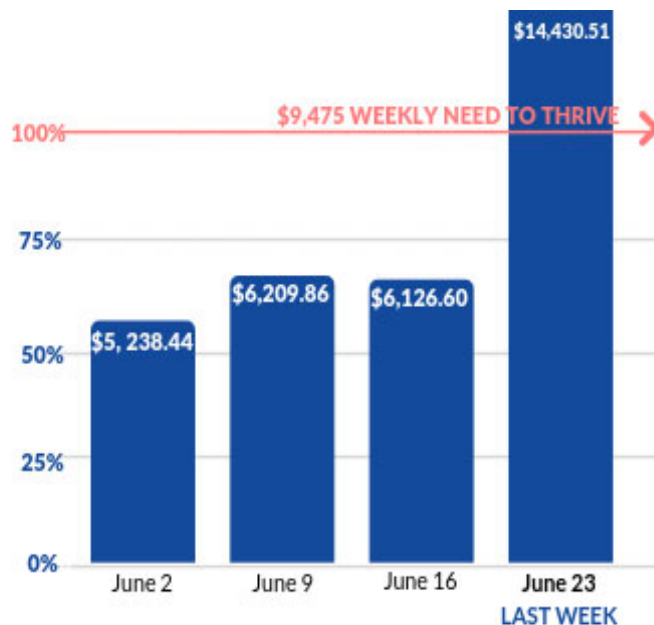
WATCH YOUR STEP—CONSTRUCTION ON FRONT STEPS SET TO BEGIN THIS WEEKEND
