#### Newark Catholic Nonviolent Action for Immigrant Children

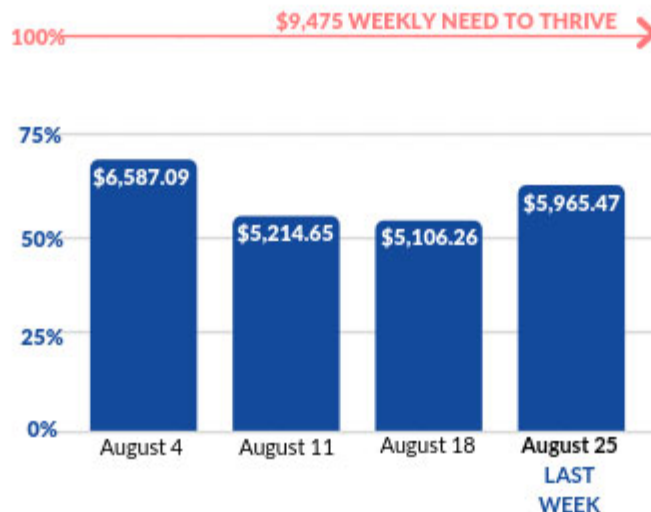
