As we enter into our colder months there are many organizations that look to us for support. We would like to lay before you a list of all our upcoming needs as we look to November and December and invite you to participate as your budget allows. *(If you, your family, or someone you know could use extra help during the holidays, please don't hesitate to speak with Jayne or Fr Kelly so we can share gifts as needed with our own parish families as well)*

At the present time, the organizations that we will partner with are: Search and Care (for Senior Citizens) Little Sisters of the Assumption Family Health Services (Food Pantry and Children's Christmas gifts), Church of the Living Hope (Clothing Closet), Ali Forney Center and Life Way Network (human trafficking).

The first items we are collecting are new packaged undergarments (male, female, boy & girl) due to the office for delivery to Church of the Living Hope by Oct 27th.

In November we will be collecting canned food for LSAFHS Food Pantry as well as personal hygiene items, protein items, socks and \$5 gift cards to create holiday gift bags for our homeless neighbors. This is a project run by our Faith Formation families, who invite all our parishioners to participate as they are able.

December will see us put tags on our Giving Tree to collect Christmas gifts for our community organizations. More details will be forthcoming for what specific items are requested by each group.

We thank you ahead of time for your continued generosity as we seek to live out our faith in many small ways, every day, through helping our neighbors.

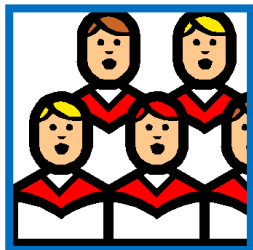
NOTICIAS DEL PROGRAMA DE EDUCACION RELIGIOSA
