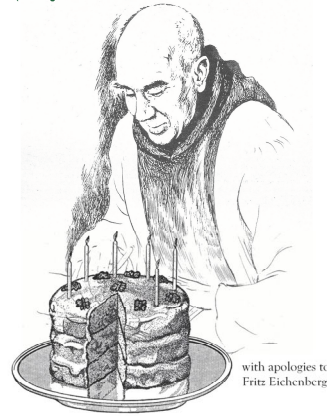

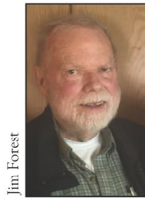
This afternoon Robert Ellsberg will recall their lives and their impact, as well as the ongoing legacy that Merton left to them and to us.

Take some time after Mass to talk about what the Gospel this week means for you, both adults and youngsters. Enjoy the insights your children can share with you!

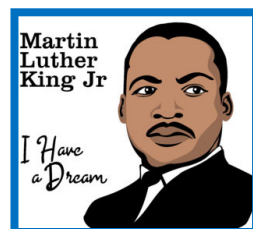
This week's question is: **Today we hear St John talking about the day he baptized Jesus...parents, tell your child a story about the day they were baptized.**

If you're looking for a fantastic group to get involved with, one that helps us live out our faith in practical ways, this is the group for you! New members are always welcome!

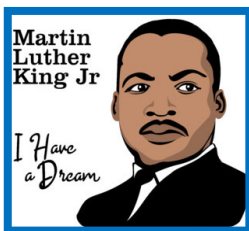

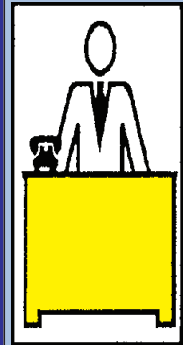
