OUR PARISH LAUDATO SI ACTION PLAN

It is fitting that a UN Conference on the **Ocean** would feature a side event on **OCEANIA** which includes Pacific Ocean nation-states such as Fiji, Samoa, Tonga, New Zealand, and Australia. Pedro Walpole, SJ, a native Irishman who grew up on the banks of the Shannon River, has served for the last 40 years on small islands in the Pacific. He was a particularly blunt panelist at this session sponsored by CARITAS International. He is tired of UN Conferences, grand speeches with little follow-up action. He yearns for a new 'economy/ecology of justice' that puts the lives and livelihoods of indigenous communities before corporate interests. He begs us to listen to the youth who have integrity and have not yet been co-opted. His memorable metaphor: the Pacific Ocean that once served as earth's largest air conditioner is now warming because of carbon emissions. Something for us to consider when we over-use our air conditioners here at home.

Pedro Walpole, SJ, un irlandés nativo que creció a orillas del río Shannon, ha servido durante los últimos 40 años en pequeñas islas del Pacífico. Fue un panelista particularmente directo en esta sesión patrocinada por CARITAS International. Está cansado de conferencias en las Naciones Unidas, grandes discursos con poca acción de seguimiento. Anhela una nueva 'economía/ecología de justicia' que anteponga las vidas y los medios de subsistencia de las comunidades indígenas a los intereses corporativos. Nos ruega que escuchemos a los jóvenes que tienen integridad y aún no han sido cooptados. Su metáfora memorable: el Océano Pacífico que una vez sirvió como el acondicionador de aire más grande de la tierra ahora se está calentando debido a las emisiones de carbono. Algo que debemos considerar cuando usamos en exceso nuestros acondicionadores de aire aquí en casa.
